## Match Reports

### ***Blandford Mens 2nds 5-1 Fleet Mens 2nds***

Most of the journey to Blandford was spent ensuring that all 11 players and umpire found the pitch on time. At the time of turning off the A303, we only had 9 players. Thankfully, Jo Edmonds managed to solve his car problems and arrived in time for the push back and settled into the Fat Back Four, making a total of 10. Fleet only had a handful of scoring opportunities in the first half, relying on break away chances. Carl Young, alone up front, did an excellent job holding up the ball, troubling the Blandford defense and giving the Fleet Engine Room time to join the attack.

Despite some resolute defending from the Fat Back Four, Fleet were 2-0 down at half time, the second from a short corner right on half time. The second half followed the same format as the first, although Chris Williams, now playing for Blandford, started to make the most of their player advantage and put several crosses into

the D. Fleet only conceded three more goals, with some fine saves from the injured Matt Pryor in goal, including one headed save. With a couple of minutes to go, Fleets 11<sup>th</sup> player arrived which gave us an extra attacking option, which Matt Gasser capitalised on by somehow squeezing a lofted ball between the post and defender.

### ***Havant Ladies 2nd 2-1 Fleet Ladies 1st***

Fleet Ladies 1<sup>st</sup> team travelled on a bitterly cold Saturday to play Havant 2<sup>nd</sup> team. In a first half of quite scrappy play from both teams, neither side could impose any sustained period of pressure, nor was it a surprise that the half remained goalless. After the interval, Havant finally managed to generate some periods of pressure, and eventually broke the deadlock from a short corner. Fleet hit back quickly to level the scores at 1-1, only to be rocked by conceding a second five minutes later. In the final 10 minutes Fleet piled pressure onto the Havant defence, generating a string of short corners, but having failed to convert any of them went down 2-1, a result that puts Havant above Fleet in the league table on goal difference.
